LOGAN'S RESERVE COMMITTEE CHARTERS

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE CHARTER

The primary responsibility of the Transportation Committee (the Committee) is to advise and assist the Board in identifying issues impacting the way we move around the community – vehicles, roads, walkways, trails – and make recommendations for handling such issues.

- 1. The Committee will field questions and concerns from the unit owners about any issues regarding roadways, walkways, sidewalks, and trails, and identify repairs or resolutions for these issues.
- 2. The Committee will routinely inspect (at an interval no less that monthly) the roadways, walkways, sidewalks, and trails and identify repairs needed.
- 3. The Committee will solicit estimates for any needed repairs, or, if the issue is covered under a contract, notify appropriate contractor for action.
- 4. The Committee will be responsible for reviewing any contracts for maintenance related to roadways, including those for snow and ice removal.
- 5. The Committee will ensure that proper maintenance is being done per any maintenance contracts.
- 6. The Committee will routinely inspect signage, including (but not limited to) street signs, speed limits, no parking, etc.
- 7. The Committee will make recommendations related to transportation safety in the community such as radar, speed limits, and traffic calming structures (i.e. speed bumps or humps).
- 8. The Committee will ensure that all transportation and parking related rules and regulations, referenced in the governing documents, including vehicle size and condition, shall be followed.
- 9. The Committee may issue any warnings and/or citations warranted by the failure to follow such rules following recommendations by the board.
- 10. The Committee will periodically review the school bus stops and routes throughout the community.
- 11. The Committee will be responsible for the oversight of security and police patrol.
- 12. The Committee will submit periodic updates to the board on any issues requiring assistance, and submit recommendations for future budget needs.
- 13. The Committee will solicit volunteers for any subcommittees needed, including special purpose committees, as needed.
